THE SWIM LAB PTE LTD GUIDELINES AND TERMS & CONDITIONS

24-HOUR NOTICE OF CANCELLATION

Parents/swimmers who made advance booking for private classes from July 22 to August 18 are to give The Swim Lab **24-hour advance notice** when canceling the class. Parents/swimmers who cancel within the 24-hour notice period will have

- i) 1 group class deducted from their existing package or
- ii) \$37.50 charged.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Students who are unable to attend class due to illness or injury will not be charged for the class **provided** parents/swimmers are able to produce a valid and original Medical Certificate.

BAD WEATHER

Classes may be cancelled or shortened due to Inclement Weather, according to the below conditions

Definition of Inclement Weather

<u>Lightning activity</u> as indicated by the lightning alert signal causing the closure of the pool by the management.

<u>Heavy rain</u> causing the closure of the pool by the management. If there is light rain, our coaches will evaluate whether lessons can continue..

<u>Haze</u> indicated by NEA 24hr PSI and 1hr PM2.5 readings in the South region 1 hour before commencement of the class *

- 1hr PM2.5 > 100: closure of pool for the complete session.
- 24hr PSI >150: closure of pool for the complete session.
- 1hr PM2.5 >55 and 24hr PSI >100: closure of pool for upcoming class
- 1hr PM2.5 <56 and 24hr PSI>100: class continues with adjusted intensity **
- * Learn to Swim: if the pool is closed due to Haze during the first 2 classes, the 3rd class of that session gets cancelled
- ** Children with chronic heart or lung conditions or sensitive breathing can opt to skip the class and request an additional makeup class whenever 24hr PSI >100 independent of 1hr PM2.5 reading
- *** Management reserves the final decision to cancel classes

Class Cancellation	Inclement Weather 15 minutes BEFORE the stipulated class start:
	Swim classes will be cancelled if bad weather persists 15 minutes before the stipulated class commencement time.
	Example: Swim class is scheduled to commence at 10:00 AM. Class will be cancelled if inclement weather persists at 9:45 AM.
	Classes cancelled due to inclement weather will not be deducted from your class package.
	Inclement Weather for 15 minutes during class:
	Swim classes will be cancelled should there be 15 minutes of consistent inclement weather.
	*Class is considered conducted if at least 30 minutes of swimming has been conducted.
	Example 1: Class is scheduled to start at 10:00 AM and there is inclement weather at 10:15 AM. Coach and student will wait for 15 mins (Until 10:30 AM). If rain/lightning persist class will be pushed back (no credits deducted)
	Example 2: Class is scheduled to start at 10:00 AM and there is inclement weather at 10:29 AM. Coach and student will wait for 15 mins (Until 10:44 AM). If rain/lightning persist class will be pushed back (no credits deducted)
	Example 3 Class is scheduled to start at 10:00 AM and there is inclement weather at 10:30 AM. Coach and student will wait for 15 mins (Until 10:45 AM). If rain/lightning persist class is considered consumed (30 mins of swimming has been conducted)
Conducted Classes	Class is considered conducted if at least 30 minutes of swimming has been conducted.
Students/Parents to Note	Should class be cancelled due to Inclement Weather, parents will be informed via our phone or WhatsApp.
	As weather can change quickly and unpredictably, any decision to cancel class due to Inclement Weather will only be made 15 mins before the stipulated class commencement time.
	We appreciate your understanding that we are unable to cancel classes at the personal preference of parents/students.
	We may initiate, at the discretion of The Swim Lab management, to cancel the class in advance, if we so deem necessary.

SAFE MANAGEMENT: COVID'19 RESTRICTION MEASURES

By enrolling your child in our swim classes, you hereby agree to comply with all prevailing Safe Management guidelines pertaining to the way we conduct our classes and your actions in our facility.

These include, but are not limited to:

- Entry to facility
 - All persons age 7 and above entering the facility are required to check-in using TraceTogether-only SafeEntry
 - You will not be permitted to enter the facility if any of the below apply to you:
 - Have tested positive for COVID-19 or had a close contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19 in the last 21 days
 - Currently have fever or flu like symptoms (cough, sore throat, fever or shortness of breath)
 - Are feeling unwell, or are serving Stay Home Notice (SHN) or Quarantined Order
 - Have a temperature above 38°
 - Entry to the facility is also subject to prevailing venue capacity limits
- Conduct of classes
- Per Sport SG guidelines, classes may only be conducted as 1 coach to 1 swimmer only.
 - Parents and observers are not permitted to participate in the class.
 - If the 1 hour class is split between siblings (up to 2), the class must be conducted as two distinct 1-on-1 classes.
 - Safe distancing of 3 metres from other groups of swimmers must be observed at all times.
 - Swimmers are required to put their masks on as soon as they exit from the water
- You agree that any refusal or inability to comply with the Safe Management guidelines may result in the cancellation of class or your removal from the premises.

PAYMENT

Fees are to be paid in full before commencement of your first lesson. Class placements are not guaranteed until payment is received in full. As our classes usually fill up quickly, and waiting lists are common, we recommend making payment for your classes sufficiently in advance.

Fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable. Payment can be made via Cash, NETS, PAYNOW, PayLah!, Bank Transfer and Cheque, or through the deduction of an existing group package at a rate of 2 group classes for 1-hour private class (for the period July 22 - August 18 only; rates are subject to change thereafter).

CHANGE OF COACH & CLASS

The Swim Lab may, as we deem necessary, change the coach for the class, for reasons including and not limited to: progression of class to a higher level and/or coach on leave/MC.

The Swim Lab may, as we deem necessary, change the class in which the student is in, for reasons including and not limited to: progression of students to a higher level and/or perceived greater compatibility.

AROUND THE POOL

Parents/ guardians are requested to accompany their child to register their attendance before class and not leave them unattended before or after their swim lesson.

Parents/ guardians are requested to refrain from actively participating in the lesson, to enable the students and coaches to concentrate on the lesson. Our customer service office on deck would be more than happy to receive your feedback any time during or after the lesson.

All students, regardless of age, gender or religion, are required to wear proper swimming attire that is made of materials specifically intended for swimming. We reserve the right to ask students who are inappropriately dressed to leave the pool.

Eating during lessons is strictly prohibited. Please refrain from bringing food to the pool deck.

Children who are not toilet trained must wear a reusable swim diaper.

Students are responsible for any personal belongings brought to classes. The Swim Lab is unable to be responsible for loss and/or damage of students' personal belongings.

RELEASE OF PHOTOS / VIDEOS

The Swim Lab may take photographs and/or video recordings of our classes and our students and/or parents/guardians for educational, training and promotional purposes. By enrolling your child in our swim classes, you hereby irrevocably grant us and our agents permission to use your image in whole or in part, without payment or any other consideration, and waive any right to inspect or approve the finished product wherein your likeness appears.

SEVERABILITY

If any portion of this Agreement is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. The above Waiver and Release of Liability is understood, and recognized as a legally binding Agreement on behalf of yourself, your child and guardians of your child to freely giving up substantial rights and assuming all risk of injury, death and property damage.
